Day 7 – October 17: The Majesty of Amer Fort

Day 8 - October 18: Elephants & Palaces

In the afternoon, visit Jaipur's architectural gems: the Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds), the City Palace, and Jantar Mantar, the world's largest stone observatory.

Day 11 - October 21: Palaces, Temples & Gardens

Morning visit to Eklingi, featuring a complex of 108 temples, carved from sandstone and marble. The main temple was built in 743 AD to invoke the blessings of Lord Shiva. Afterwards continue to Nadga, known for its intricately carved 10th century temples. Afternoon visit to the Garden of Maidens (Saheliyon-ki-Bari).
